ART. 1 FINANCIAL REQUIREMENTS

The Art. 3 of the Call for assignment of Financial Aid Benefits A.Y. 2022/2023 – issued by the Management Decree Ref.136090/2022 (hereinafter also “*the Call*”), is supplemented as follows:

ISEE/ISEEU Parificato and ISPE/ISPEU limits

Students requesting Financial Aid Benefits (hereinafter also “*DSU benefits*”) should have:

- an ISEE/ISEEU Parificato (issued for the sake of obtaining “*benefits for the right to higher education*”) not higher than **€ 24.335,11**;
- an ISPE/ISPEU calculated by dividing the ISP value (Assets Status Indicator provided by INPS) by the equivalency scale, not higher than **€ 52.902,43**.

Regardless of their merit, students whose ISEE/ISEEU Parificato or ISPE/ISPEU exceeds the abovementioned limits will be excluded from the assignment of DSU benefits.

Independent student

A student is defined as “independent” when the following requirements are met conjunctly:

- The student has had a different and separate residence from their family’s one for at least two years from the subscription of the Dichiarazione Sostitutiva Unica, and such a residence is not located in a property owned by their family;
- The student has been perceiving for two years an own, fiscally declared income derived from an employment relationship or assimilated no lower than **€ 9.000,00**. Such activities must not be carried out under an individual who is bonded to the student through kinship. If the independent student, basing on their civil status certificate, is cohabiting with another person, the incomes of both people must be considered mandatorily, even if they are not relatives.

ART. 2 DSU SCHOLARSHIPS: NUMBER AND VALUE

Art. 13 of the Call is supplemented as follows: there are **4.300** DSU scholarships available, divided up as below:

Students enrolled in the first year of PhD and specialisation courses	10

Students enrolled in subsequent years of PhD and specialisation courses	10

Income brackets

The income brackets through which DSU Scholarship amounts are determined are the following:

Scholarship amounts based on student's income brackets and geographical origin

The DSU scholarship's amounts, considering both the income bracket and student's geographic origin, are determined as follows:

Local student	
1 st bracket	€ 2.415,00 + one free meal per day for a total of € 3.127,00
2 nd bracket	€ 2.007,00 + one free meal per day for a total of € 2.719,00
3 rd bracket	€ 1.220,00 + one free meal per day for a total of € 1.932,00

Commuter student	
1 st bracket	€ 3.427,00 + one free meal per day for a total of € 4.139,00
2 nd bracket	€ 2.887,00 + one free meal per day for a total of € 3.599,00
3 rd bracket	€ 2.121,00 + one free meal per day for a total of € 2.833,00

Away from home student housed in Politecnico di Milano residences	
1 st bracket	€ 3.967,00 + housing + one free meal per day for a total of € 7.082,00
2 nd bracket	€ 3.043,00 + housing + one free meal per day for a total of € 6.158,00
3 rd bracket	€ 1.914,00 + housing + one free meal per day for a total of € 5.029,00

Away from home student housed in other accommodations, either public or private	
1 st bracket	€ 6.370,00 + one free meal per day for a total of € 7.082,00
2 nd bracket	€ 5.446,00 + one free meal per day for a total of € 6.158,00
3 rd bracket	€ 4.317,00 + one free meal per day for a total of € 5.029,00

For students enrolled in the academic year 2022/2023 who are beneficiary of DSU for their additional term of all courses and students enrolled in the first year of Master of Science courses starting from the second term, the amount of their scholarship, as well as their services' deductions, will be reduced by 50%.

Students with certified disability of 66% or higher can get the annual amount of their scholarship increased up to 40% on top of the one they are entitled to, for a final benefit amounting to a maximum of:

€ 4.378,00 for local students
€ 5.795,00 for commuter students
€ 9.915,00 for away from home students

ART. 3 SCHOLARSHIP'S INCREASE

Female students with an ISEE level corresponding to 2nd or 3rd bracket who are enrolled in study courses related to STEM disciplines (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics), the amount of their scholarship is subject to a 20% increase.

Under current legislation, students who are enrolled in more than one study course simultaneously (with the exemption of online courses) are allowed to keep their scholarship increased by 20%, insofar as they own and maintain the academic merit established by the Call throughout the duration of their courses.

The abovementioned increase is no longer applied if the student does not meet the scholarship's requirements for the study course for which they received such an increase in the first place.

Further details will be applied after the emanation of the decree of Ministero dell'Università e della Ricerca as per art. 4 of the Law n.33 as of April 12th 2022.

ART. 4 CANTEEN SERVICE DEDUCTION

Art. 19 of the Call is supplemented as follows:

A **deduction** equal to € 712.00 will be made from the amount of the DSU scholarship. The first 50%

will be deducted from the first instalment of DSU scholarship, whilst the remaining 50% will be deducted from the second instalment.

Assigned students enrolled in the Online School of Engineering of Computing Systems may request for the abovementioned deduction not to be made. This request must be submitted by no later than **December 20th 2022** exclusively through the email¹ address indicated on www.polimi.it/diritto-allo-studio (select: *Canteen Service*).

Submissions sent after the deadline and/or through a different channel than the indicated one will not be considered.

ART. 5 ACCOMMODATION DEDUCTION FOR STUDENTS HOUSED IN POLITECNICO DI MILANO'S RESIDENCES

Art. 29 of the Call is supplemented as follows:

A **deduction** equal to € 2.403,00 will be made from the amount of the scholarship for students housed in Politecnico di Milano's residences.

ART. 6 ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR STUDENTS ENROLLED THE IN FIRST YEAR OF BACHELOR OF SCIENCE PROGRAMS AND SINGLE-CYCLE MASTER OF SCIENCE PROGRAMS

The content of Art. 4.1 is modified as follows:

Students who enrol in the **FIRST YEAR** of Bachelor of Science or Single-Cycle Master of Science courses must enrol **without total OFA** (Additional Educational Obligations). The presence or absence of OFA will be assessed **exclusively**² upon enrolment of the student. Enrolment with solely OFA in English does not constitute cause for exclusion.

Along with absence of OFA, the following requirements are established:

- Students who enrol in their first year of **Design and Urbanistic courses** must pass their admission test with a score equal or higher than 60/100;
- Students who enrol in their first year of **Architectural Design and Ingegneria Edile ed Architettura** courses must pass their admission test with a score equal or higher than **30/50**.

ART. 7 GRADUATION AWARD AS AN INTEGRATION TO DSU SCHOLARSHIP

Art. 21 of the Call is supplemented as follows:

Students who achieve their Masters of Science or Single-Cycle Master of Science degree within the

official timeframe established for the respective degree courses will benefit of an integration of their DSU scholarship equal to half of the amount which they got assigned during their last year of studies, excluding deductions for accommodation and canteen service.

The integration will be provided to graduates who will meet the following requirements conjunctly:

- the student must have graduated in the number of years equal to a normal duration of the Master of Science or Single-Cycle Master of Science program which they are applying the degree award for. The calculation of the normal duration is made starting from the absolute first year of enrolment. As such, any student who, for whichever reason, enrolls in the third year of a Master of Science program or in the sixth year of a single-cycle Master of Science program will be excluded from the assignment of this benefit;
- The student must have received the DSU Scholarship for the academic year which they are requesting the degree award for;
- The student must not have received the degree award benefit over the course of their entire university career.

The Financial Aid Unit will proceed with the issuance of the integration for graduates who will fulfil the abovementioned criteria.

Consequently, Art. 21.1 is repealed.

ART. 8 ACCOMMODATION AT REDUCED RATE

The first part of **Art. 22** of the Call is supplemented as follows:

The competition for the allocation of the preferential rate residence service is open to students who are regularly enrolled in the academic year 2022/2023 and who are NOT residents in a Municipality classified as an urban area and from which it is NOT possible to reach the location of their course within 90 minutes by public transport.

Art. 8.1 Assignment of residence slots

The first part of **Art. 28** of the Call is supplemented as follows:

Students **enrolled in subsequent years** of all study programs have the right to benefit from the residence services **from August 29th 2022 until July 31st 2023**.

Students **enrolled in the first year** of all study programs have the right to benefit from the assigned residence services from the **beginning of the programs** (as indicated in the Academic Calendar) **until July 31st 2023**.

The assignment of the residence slots is subjected to the verification of the correct registration or enrolment of the student in the academic year 2022/2023. Such an assignment will be carried out in light of the slots available in each Residence, as well as of the student's position within the ranking. The potential preference expressed by the student is not binding for assignment purposes.

Art. 8.2 Declined right of residence

Art. 32 of the Call is supplemented as follows:

The student who is assigned a residence slot loses such a benefit in the event of:

- does not finalise their enrolment to Politecnico di Milano courses for the academic year 2022/2023 by the deadlines established by the academic calendar;
- transfer to another university;
- withdrawal from their studies;
- application of disciplinary sanctions stated in Politecnico di Milano's Regulation of University Residences;
- lack of payment of residence fees;
- achieving a degree without enrolling in a higher-level study program at Politecnico di Milano.

ART. 9 REFERENCE


Other regulations contained in the Call issued by Management Decree Ref. 136090 dated on June 1st 2022 remain unaffected.
